**In the Spirit of Woodstock, the Spirit of Freedom in Paint**

This summer, Tony Canger will be the subject of a major art exhibition at the Liberty Museum and Arts Center. The exhibition entitled "In the Spirit of Woodstock, the Spirit of Freedom in Paint" features Mr. Canger's paintings from the 1960s. Paintings on display include "Tiger's Eye" (Oil), "Horizons" (Oil), and "The Betrothal" (Oil).

Born in Paterson, NJ, Tony Canger attended the Cooper Union and the Art Students League in New York City, and Seton Hall University in New Jersey.

In 1968-69 he moved to Italy, studying mural painting, abandoning abstraction and committed himself to figurative painting. Upon his return he moved to Soho, NYC 1974-90. He showed his work at Forum Gallery NYC and D.F.N Gallery NYC and taught painting, drawing and art history at Seton Hall University, Newark School of Art NJ and Morris County College NJ and also was a member of the Mayors Council on the Arts, 1979-80 in NYC.

He showed his work at the Montclair Museum NJ, the New Jersey Museum and the Brooklyn Museum. Tony was also awarded grants from the New Jersey Council on the Arts and the Adolf Gottlieb Foundation NYC. Tony also has made four art/documentary films, namely the award winning film "The Feast" which was accepted by the Library of Congress. He currently lives in Swan Lake, New York.

This short film was based on his 8'x10' painting and actual footage of Italian immigrants celebrating the feast day of St. Michael in Paterson, NJ.

The exhibit will be on display at the museum until Sunday, August 18th.


